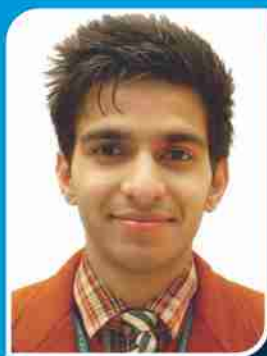

Best Teacher Award (Session 2013-14)

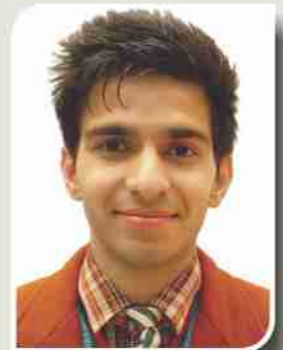

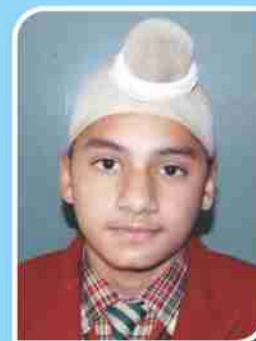

The Annual Day was celebrated on December 1, 2013. The Ballet titled 'Kal Aaj Kal' depicted the journey of evolution of mankind.

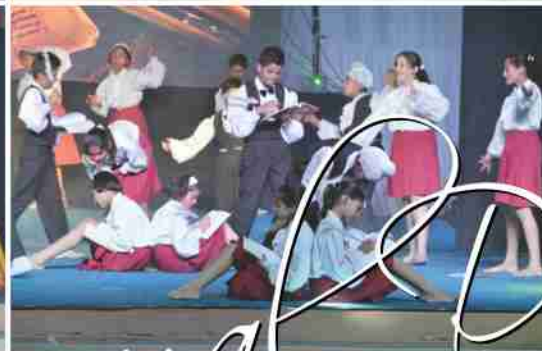
The Ballet revealed through its scenes, the transition of Man through the ages.

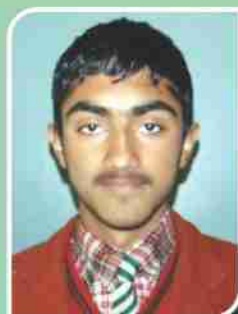

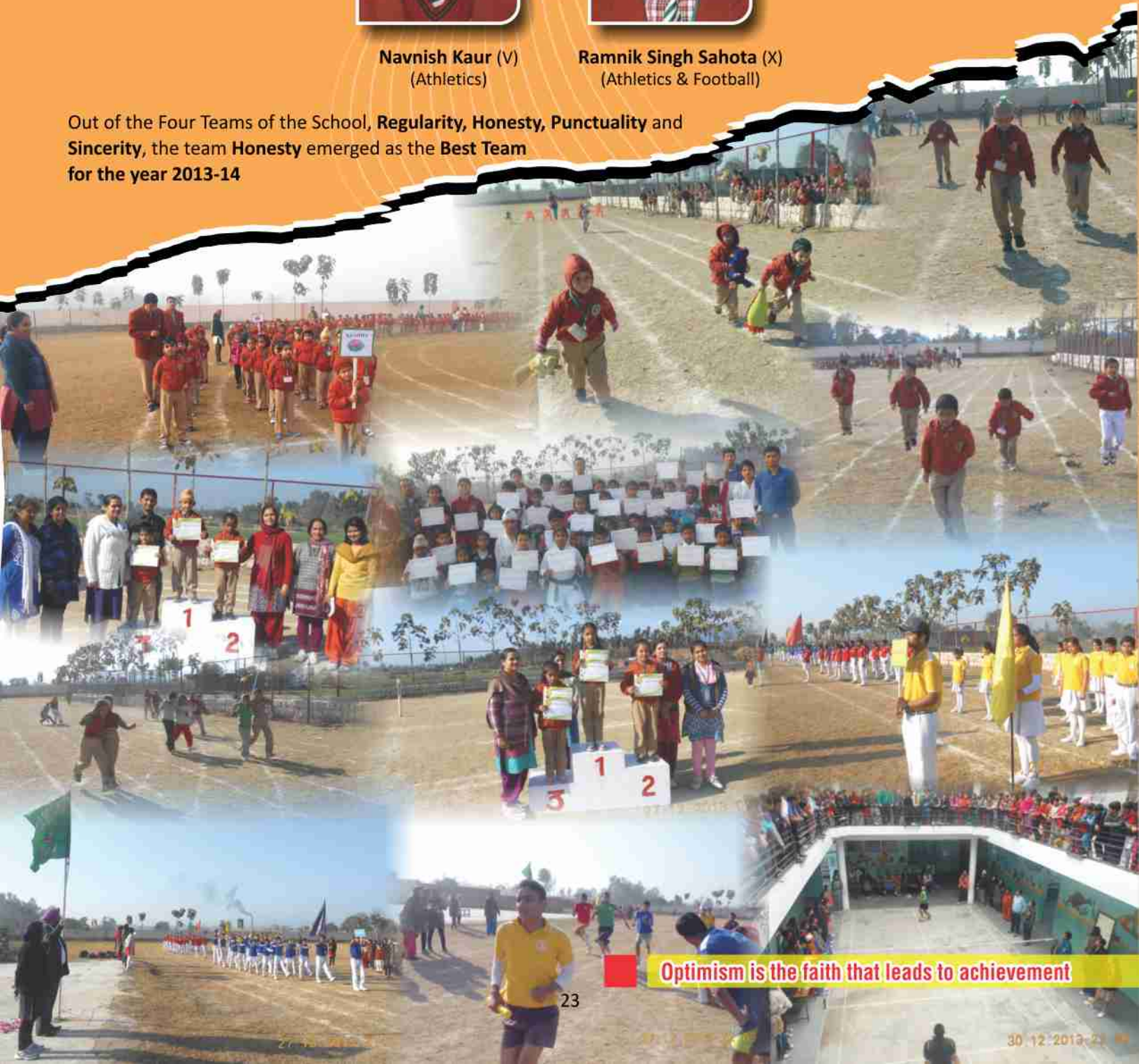

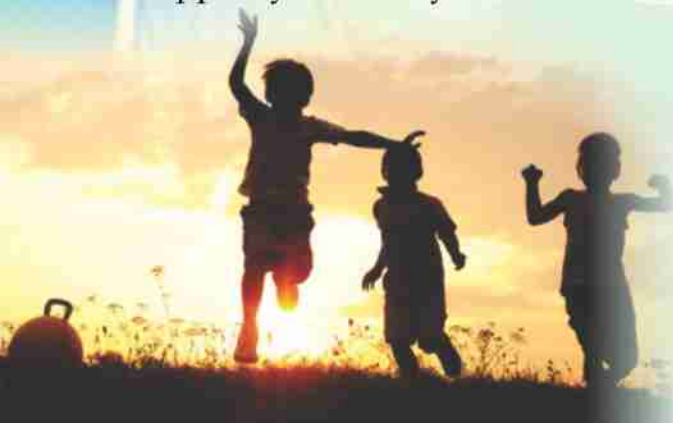
